

AUTHOR'S AWARD NOMINATION

Definition This award honors an individual who has published an HIM article that instructs or guides members with new theoretical concepts or further develops concepts previously presented in the AHIMA Journal, or in NYHIMA publications, or in a nationally recognized publication or published by commercial publishers within the past two (2) calendar years

Qualified Candidate Must be an **ACTIVE** member in good standing at the national, state, and local level
NYHIMA members who receive a stipend for publishing work for NYHIMA are ineligible for consideration

Examples of Written Work Authored book (co-author), book chapter, article, monograph, instructional guide

Evaluation of Written Work Work will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Providing tools to educate health information professionals or general public
- Presenting new theoretical concepts or further development of concepts previously presented
- Detailing hands-on practice techniques that are ready for implementation
