Eligibility Requirements: Applicants must (1) hold student or active membership in AHIMA and NYHIMA and be in good standing with both, and (2) be enrolled either part-time or full-time in a New York State CAHIIM Accredited Associate or Baccalaureate program, and (3) have completed 12 credit hours, and (4) have maintained a minimum GPA of 3.0. Applicants meeting the preceding requirements may apply annually for all awards, but multiple scholarships will not be awarded to a single individual in a given year. Individuals receiving an award are ineligible for that scholarship in succeeding years.

Instructions: (1) Complete this form, indicating the scholarship(s) for which you are applying; (2) Submit a typewritten essay on the topic(s) as specified below. Essays will be scored on adherence to topic, format (must contain an introduction, body and conclusion), use of original ideas and/or concepts, coherence, completeness and grammatical correctness. Winners' essays are published in Perspectives Online, the NYHIMA newsletter.
